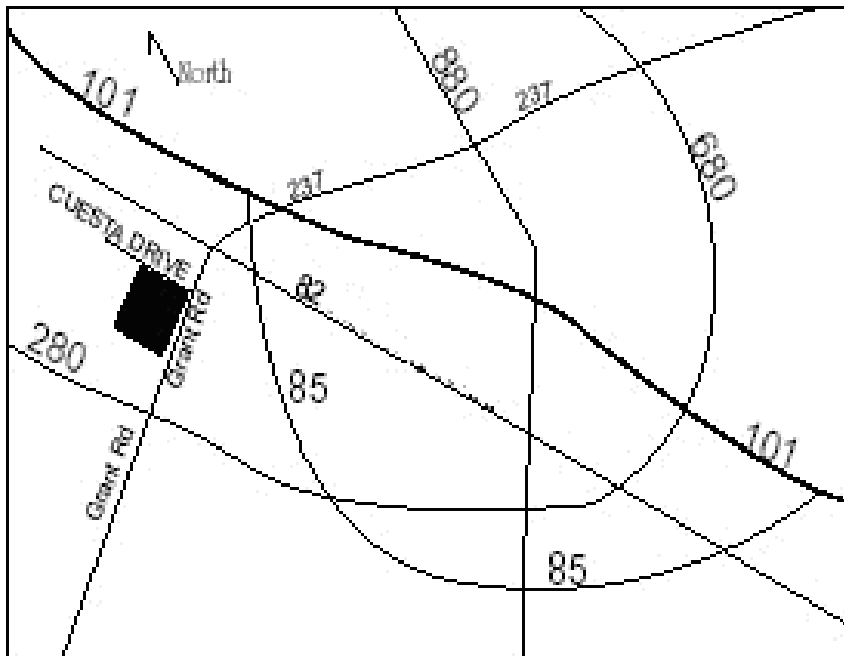

Effective **February 1, 2000**, the following changes have been adopted by the Board of Directors.

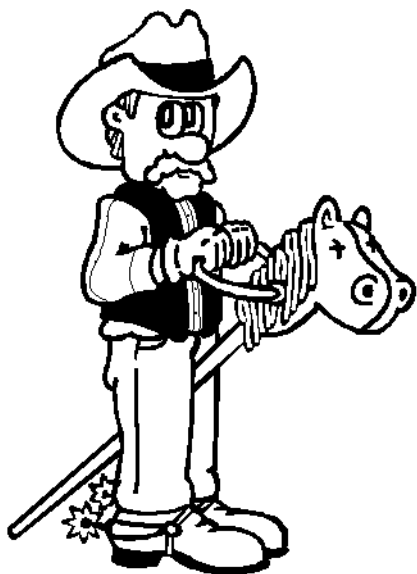
A **\$1.00 per animal** fine will be assessed for all entries postmarked after the date specified in the show catalog, **(Rule #4 of Show Rules)**

SHOW RULES

1. This is an **ARBA & ACBA Sanctioned OPEN & YOUTH SHOW**. The show will be governed by the latest revised rules of ARBA and ACBA. Signing and submitting of the entry form this implies acceptance of these rules.
2. This is a one day carrying cage show to be held at Cuesta Park in Mountain View, CA. The show will be held on June 21, 2008.
3. Cavy entries **MUST** be postmarked no later than Wednesday, June 11, 2008. Please mail entries to the show secretary:

4. Check or Money Order must accompany the entry.
5. **Make check or Money Order payable to GSCBA**
6. Your phone number must be on the entry form.
7. Calls made for incomplete or illegible entry information will be made collect.
8. Phone changes will be accepted until **8:00PM June 18th** by calling the show Secretary. **After 8:00PM June 18th, any changes of Breed, Sex, Variety or class will not be made. Ear tag changes will be made at the show, before judging begins, with a cost of \$1.00 per change.**
9. **Both shows will begin at 9 AM..**
10. No Certified Mail will be accepted.
11. All judging comment cards, specials, and/or trophies must be picked up at the show. They will not be mailed or delivered. Legs will be mailed with the exhibitors report.
12. All exhibitors are responsible for their animals to and from the judging tables. GSCBA will not attempt to provide carriers.
13. All Animals are entered at the owner's risk. Show personnel and the judges are in no way responsible for death, injury or loss of any animal, but all possible care will be taken to safeguard the animals.
14. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children. Parents will be required to repair any all damage caused by their children. If damage is of a nature that cannot be repaired, the parent will be responsible to pay for the repair costs

incurred. The GSCBA may refuse entry of that youth at other GSCBA shows.

15. No person, other than show officials, judges, and clerks shall be allowed behind the judging tables during judging.
16. All cavies must be permanently earmarked in the left ear, and ear markings must correspond with entry form.
17. **No selling of items, including Animals and used items, allowed at the park. Anyone violating this rule risks being cited by the city of Mountain View, and will be asked to leave the park. No refunds of entries will be given.**
18. The Show Chairman reserves the right to assign, reassign, add or substitute judges as necessary.
19. Any and all questions not covered by these or ARBA rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and Superintendent. All parties shall abide by these decisions.

Special Events and Services

Youth Showmanship Practice

Tune up for fair and get some feedback on your showmanship technique from experienced showmen. We will have classes for beginning, novice and advanced, and will give you on the spot feedback.

Sign up day of show. The showmanship will run concurrently with the show, so come and do your routine in between your classes. While this is for fun and for learning, we will announce results and there are ribbons for the top scores in each division. You don't have to wear your whites!



The Great Chips and Salsa Taste Off!

Since we won't be serving a BBQ lunch this year, we are going to have a chips and salsa tasting competition. Bring your favorite chips and salsa to share and enter in the People's Choice judging. Extra points for homemade or bought at that little family-run place nobody knows about but you.

Cavy Registrar Available

There will be a licensed cavy registrar at the show. In order to register a cavy you need:

1. Valid ARBA Card, which you must show to the registrar. The owner of the cavy must be present to sign the application.
2. Cavy must be 6 months old, with no disqualifications. This means it must weigh above 32 ounces, be an accepted variety, and be free of conditions such as Pea Eye or coat faults. The registrar will weigh and inspect the cavy to determine if it is eligible for registration.
3. Must have a 3 generation pedigree showing all one breed - NO mixed breeds (such as a satin in a standard or silkie in a peruvian)
4. \$6.00 to pay for registration.

Why Register a Cavy?

If you earn enough legs at shows, if your cavy is registered you can send those legs in to ARBA and receive a Grand Champion Certificate for the cavy.
